

Pet Allergy Drop Instructions

First-time use of your new drop bottle and dispenser

1. Three bottle sequence. The drops come in 3 strengths (A, B, and C). Your first prescription will contain two bottles, labeled “A” (weakest strength) and “B” (medium strength). Begin treatment with bottle “A.” Once you have completed this bottle, begin bottle “B.” Your second prescription order will contain two bottles of “C” (highest strength). After you have used bottle “B,” begin bottle “C” and continue with this strength for the duration of your maintenance.



2. Priming the dispenser. To begin using the dispenser, you will need to prime the pump by first removing the colored plastic safety clip and depressing the pump several times firmly and quickly, until a dose is released.

The safety clip should be kept from small children and pets as it may pose a choking hazard. Bottles should be stored in the refrigerator.



3. Dispensing the drops. Rest the dispensing arm of the pump on the lower teeth, anywhere near the front or side of the mouth, with the tip over the edge of the teeth, as shown.

Depress the pump firmly and quickly, so that the dose is released under the tongue. Repeat once, for a total of two pumps per dose. The solution has a slightly sweet taste that most dogs like. The dose must be dispensed into the mouth, under the tongue if possible.

Do not mix the drops with food or on a treat. Avoid giving food or water for 10 minutes after giving the dose so it will remain in the mouth as long as possible.

Daily dosing

Administer the 2-pump dose twice per day, for example, morning and evening. The doses do not have to be given at the same time every day. If you miss a day, do not try to “catch up” by giving additional doses; just continue treatment the next day. Each bottle will last approximately 75 days.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTE:

In the unlikely event that your pet experiences a reaction, give an antihistamine and call your veterinarian. Do not resume drops until you have discussed it with your veterinarian.
